

MEMORIAL MARKERS AND NICHE PLATES RULES AND REGULATIONS

Elsinore Valley Cemetery District ("EVCD") is a special public cemetery district governed by a Board of Trustees ("Board") that has statutory authority to exercise all rights and powers to own, operate, improve and maintain cemeteries. The California Health and Safety Code along with other California statutes has empowered the Board to adopt said rules and regulations. These Interment Rules and Regulations shall be reviewed annually by the Board; however, the Board can amend these Rules and Regulations at any time.

MEMORIAL MARKERS:

- 1. All markers are subject to approval by the District Manager or other person authorized by the Board.
- 2. A marker setting fee will be charged for each memorial marker set. If an existing marker is replaced with a new marker, a marker disposal fee of \$25.00 is required.
- 3. Upright markers are not permitted. All markers must be flush, full size granite at least 3" thick with a L.M.P. (lawn mower proof) edges, or made of U.S. Standard bronze. All markers will be set by District personnel or District agents.
- 4. EVCD allows two (2) headstones per single burial plot: one 16"x28" and one 12"x18".
- 5. EVCD is not responsible for any damages to the marker. District personnel will use as much caution as possible to protect markers; however scratches, fading and the buildup of calcium may occur and EVCD is not responsible for such wear and tear.
- 6. EVCD is not responsible for the cleaning of any markers.

NICHE PLATES:

7. Engraving on niche plates will consist of: first name, middle initial, last name, year of birth and year of death only. No pictures, paper or any other object shall be placed on the niche plate.

These rules and regulations were approved by the Board of Trustees of the Elsinore Valley Cemetery District and are subject to change without notice.
